CONSTITUENT CONCERNS

Old concerns:

- Vending machines not accepting credit cards Vendor replaced malfunctioning machines. Resolved.
- Pickleball court on GT Campus Terry Evelyn (Facilities Director, GT Campus) is in process to identify the tennis court to be renovated for two pickleball courts. Cost estimates are being worked on. More to follow.
- Banners by the poles in the BE Bldg are flopping around A request to Facilities Dept had been placed. No resolution yet.

New concerns:

- [Shakeena Adams-Gormley] Cars and trucks parked along Goldenrod Ln. are becoming a hazard. They limit/block drivers' view of the road, sometimes causing vehicles to swerve into opposing traffic lanes. *Action:* Sharon will contact MC Public Safety to request County Police to enforce the parking hours. Sharon added that once in a while the parked vehicles are all cleared out, but they soon return after.
- [Erin Marcinek] Same thing is happening on Observation Dr. by Holy Cross Hospital.
- [Teresa Lew] Difficult to make left turn out of the PK parking lot onto Goldenrod Ln as well because of large trucks blocking the view.

- Provided update about Slingshot (new campus store partner for bookstore services and course materials).
- Slingshot commenced operations this month (March 2025).

- Former GT campus store will become a distribution hub with smaller footprint.
