**MARYMOUNT UNIVERSITY NOTES**

Students that complete the Associate of Arts degree at Montgomery College will be considered core complete at Marymount University, with the exception of one core course in theology (TRS 100). Students that do not complete the Associate of Arts degree at Montgomery College will need to complete additional courses to fulfill Marymount's Liberal Arts Core requirements.

#Recommended General elective options at MC- PSYC 221 (equivalent to PSY 230, which is an approved CJ elective course); SOCY 233 (equivalent to SOC 222, which is an approved CJ elective course); CCJS 215 (equivalent to CJ 312, which is a required course for the CJ major). Completion of any of these courses at MC may adjust remaining courses at MU.

Most minors at Marymount are 15 credits, or 12 additional credits if students have taken a course in the minor field such as communications, sociology, political science, law, or psychology.
